

SCRSS 2026 Season - Week NINE Recap

On another beautiful morning at Mahany Field, we were back to our normal schedule, with two games on the north field.

Wednesday– May 20

9:30 – Your Roofing Contractor at **Oakmont**. As has become routine for them, **YRC** scored five runs in their half of the 1st inning, but **Oakmont** scored two runs to stay close. **YRC** did not score in the 2nd, while **Oakmont** scored one to trail **5-3**. **YRC** added five more runs in the 3rd and **Oakmont** added four, to trail **YRC 10-7**. **YRC** then scored two in the 4th, five more in the 5th and another five in the top of the 6th, taking advantage of multiple **Oakmont** errors to lead **22-9**. **Oakmont** failed to score in the 6th, so both teams agreed to “flip flop” and **Oakmont** hit again in the top of the 7th. They did manage to score three more runs, but **YRC** won **22-12**. **YRC's** Darryl Hilscher was 4x4, Henry Salazar, Rodney Milton and Jim Rhoe were 3x3, Pedro Atchison was 3x4 and Mike Barrientos contributed a H.R. and a double. In an interesting note, **YRC's** team batting avg. was .488, while their bottom six hitters (B6) hit .529. *This can often guarantee a win.* **Oakmont's** Mark McGushin was 4x4 with a triple, Emilio Lobato was 3x4 with a H.R., while Barry Speier, Rod Rogers, and Tana Montgomery were 2x3. While the team's BA was .650, their B6 average was only .353.

11:00 – Eskaton at **Ivy Blue Oaks**. **Eskaton** opened the game with two runs, while **Ivy Blue Oaks** scored four in their half of the 1st. **Eskaton** then scored five in the 2nd, and **Ivy Blue Oaks** scored two, so **Eskaton** led **7-6** after two innings. **Eskaton** failed to score in the 3rd & 4th, while **Ivy Blue** scored five runs in the 3rd to lead **11-7**. **Eskaton** scored four runs in the 5th and three more in the 6th to lead **Ivy Blue 14-12** going to the bottom of the 6th. **Ivy Blue** then scored five runs in their half and led **17-14** going into the open inning. Unfortunately, **Eskaton** failed to score, thus **Ivy Blue's** 6th inning comeback won the game **17-14**. **Eskaton's** substitute Darryl Hilscher was 4x4 with a double, Barry Schivo was 4x4, and Mike Hall was 3x3. Jim Parker was 3x4, while Steve Mohatt and Mike Worsham were 2x4. Pitcher Lou Farkas was 2x3. **Eskaton's** team avg. was .585 and their B6 avg. was .476. **Ivy Blue Oak's** Randy Wingo was 3x3, Frank Tom and Manny Franco were both 3x4. John Pyle, Gene Korte, and Dan Nelson were 2x3. Their team avg. was .643 and their B6 avg. was higher, at .647.

Next week's games (May 27) will be impacted by teams losing some players to Reno's Rock'n Reno tournament. Please note that no games are scheduled for June 3 but stay tuned, as remaining rained out games may be played.
