

## SCRSS 2026 Season - Week Seven Recap

Despite lots of rain early this week that made Mahany's north field unplayable, the south field handled the rain well enough for our league games to be played under windless, cloudy skies. To make-up for our two previous rainouts, both Mahany fields will be used next week in twin double-headers. Should be an interesting morning for everyone.

### Wednesday– May 6

**9:30 – Oakmont at Eskaton.** Oakmont scored two runs in the top of the 1st inning, and Eskaton scored one in their half. Oakmont scored four in the 2nd, while Eskaton failed to score. Oakmont then scored three runs in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and five more runs in the 4<sup>th</sup> to lead **14-1**. Eskaton scored two in their half of the 4<sup>th</sup>, to make the score **14-3**. Oakmont added four more runs in the 5<sup>th</sup>, while Eskaton failed to score; Oakmont now led **18-3**. After Oakmont did not score in the top of the sixth, Eskaton scored four runs in the bottom of the 6<sup>th</sup> cutting their deficit to **18-7**. Eskaton asked to “flip-flop,” so after the 6<sup>th</sup> inning ended, they remained at-bat for the top of the 7<sup>th</sup>. They failed to score, so Oakmont won the game **18-7**. Eskaton's Alan Conrad was 3x3 with two doubles and five RBI, while Ray Harrison and Mike Hau were 2x3. Eskaton's team B.A. was .417; their bottom 6 B.A. was .278. Oakmont's Bob Montalvo was 4x4 with a double, and Barry Speier was 4x4 with three RBI. Emilio Lobato was 3x4 with two doubles and four RBI, while Ron Roberts was 3x4 with a triple and two RBI. Dale Miles and Tana Montgomery were also 3x4. Oakmont's team B.A. was .568; their bottom 6 B.A. was .500.

**11:00 – YRC at Ivy Blue Oaks.** YRC scored in all but one inning for a total of 19 runs, while Ivy Blue Oaks failed to score in six of their seven innings, resulting in a 19-1 loss to YRC. Ivy Blue Oak's offense was led by Randy Baldwin and Manny Franco who were 2x3, but they were unable to overcome the lack of timely hitting by their teammates. Their team B.A. was .290, while their bottom 6 B.A. was .250. YRC's Mike Barrientos was 4x4 with three doubles, while Pedro Atchison and Jim Rhoe were 3x3. There was a lot of support from everyone else, with a team B.A. of .714 and more importantly, a batting average of .857 from their last six hitters!
